🧭 Know what to bring

If you need specific clothing or equipment for your first day on the job, it's likely your employer will provide it for you. But it's always worth checking if there is anything you should bring – just ask your Recruiter.

🕑 Get organised the night before

Pack your bag, arrange your clothes and get any paperwork ready so that you're not scrambling on your first day.
